An essential step is to identify a potential **tandem partner** among experienced researchers from the **University Alliance Ruhr (UA Ruhr)** and develop a concept for a joint project.

Tandem partners must submit a **letter of intent** expressing their endorsement of the fellowship.



Who can apply?

Advanced senior researchers who meet the following prerequisites:

- active member of a foreign university or research institution
- outstanding research profile in the social sciences and/or the humanities
- doctorate completed at least six years prior to the application
